## Travel - Destinations



### Namibia

Namibia in the South West of Africa is said to be the "rough diamond" of the Black Continent. The greatest fascination of this sparsely populated country is its multitude of overwhelming landscapes in all forms and colours – from endless plains to sky high dunes.

The first DESTINATION is the capital Windhoek, where on every corner you find hints of its long history as a German colony especially noticeable in the architecture and names of many locations.



We visit the desert of Namib. Its incredible vastness stretches along the Atlantic coast with dunes up to 300 meters (1000 ft.) high – the highest in the world.

The last DESTINATION is the Etosha National Park where you find all the animals, that you associate with Africa, an up-close look at lions and elephants, ostriches and giraffes...



### South Tyrol / Italien Alps (Winter)

Winter in the Italian Alps is an experience of impressive beauty: the unique panorama of this towering mountain range called "Dolomites", picturesque villages look like they are powdered with sugar – altogether one of the vastest ski areas in Europe.

Our first DESTINATION is the small Alp town of Sterzing. Only a few minutes from the centre of this typical South Tyrolian place a ropeway starts on its way up to the high mountaintop – a real paradise for skiers and snowboarders.



Even more widespread is the winter sport's region of the "Taufere Ahrntal", surrounded by 80 mountains with a height of more than 3000 meters above sea level – and still an insider's tip for all winter activities you can imagine. Why not race down the mountain serpentines on sledges? Even at night! Or try free climbing on icy walls.



### China

With a population of more than 1,2 billion people China has more inhabitants than any other country in the world. Its old traditions and culture, together with its enormous endeavours for economic progress, make China an attractive DESTINATION for travellers from everywhere.

Our journey begins in Beijing – political, economic and cultural centre of the "People's Republic". The heart of the 13-million-people city is the Tiananmen Square, the largest square in the world.



Only two hours away the DESTINATIONS route leads us to one of the most famous monuments on earth: The Great Chinese Wall, more than 6.000 km long.

A gigantic symbol of modern China is the Gezhouba embankment dam, the largest dam project on earth.



### Ecuador / Galapagos

Discover the smallest country of South America, offering a grand variety of impressions: the majestic mountain ranges of the Andes, intact white beaches and a fascinating fauna.

Our first DESTINATION is Quito, Ecuador's colourful capital with 2,2 million inhabitants. The heart of the Colonial Old Town is the Plaza de la Independencia. Its Cathedral La Compania is a symbol of the Spanish emperors.



Quite the opposite is the typical little village of San Miguel el Quinchel, where we take part in the lively annual festival for the patron saint.

Ecuador is also a land of volcanoes. The highest active volcano is called Cotopaxi, a perfectly formed cone that gave the mountain its wonderful name: the neck of the moon.

Africa - A continent full of Mysteries. We cross the continent from North to South, from Tunis to Cape Town, we pass endless deserts, tropical rainforests, wide savannahs, crossing mountain ridges and river beds and we meet people of different tribes and get into their rites and living. We face problems with the Van and everything turned out different to what we expected. We started with 4 other vehicles and stayed behind.

Africa offers original culture and nature, that means that we - a group of people with their camper vans - leave civilization as we know it from Europe, America and Australia. We get in touch with unknown ways of living and fight the very bad road conditions on our way. We do not stay in hotels, but in our camper vans on campsites or in the very wilderness. First our route leads us through the Arabian world. Our Adventure starts in Tunis (Tunesia), where we arrive by ship. We visit the old town of Tunis, with its bazars and markets full of oriental spices and carpets. Route Description: Xmas Eve in Tunesia under Palm trees

Soon we get problems with our Van, which stops us for three weeks and different garages where looking at the problem. The group continued their journey and we stayed behind. We will not meet again.

With good luck we get the car running by ourseves and head on to Libya, a country which was closed by the president Gadafi for several years. It was hard to get a visa and we had to get an offical guide, who accompanied us through the country to the Egyptian border. On our way we visit old towns, built by the Romans, like Leptis Magna and visit original desert oasis.

After entering Egypt, we drive along the Mediterranean Coast to Alexandria and further on to Cairo with its marvelous Pyramids and busy bazars and gorgous mosks.

We go on travelling South, crossing black and white desert, meet the Nile River Valley, continue to Luxor, where we visit the ancient culture of the Pharaos. In Aswan we had to stop to arrange everything for the ferry to Wadi Halfa in Sudan. A very difficult decision

had to be made: Our dog Tara has to go alone on the barque for two days, and we had to take the passenger ferry. We stayed at a Nubian House and had a nice Feluka Ride on the River Nile. In Asswan we have to take the ferry to Wadi Halfa in Sudan.

### twentyonedays

african big game is the star of this series of 22 documentaries. Each episode follows a specific hunt, recounting the hunter's point of view with the enthusiasm, attention to detail and care characteristic of a private journal. The firearms, techniques, strategies and preparation for each hunt are described in detail, as are all the sensations, excitements and disappointments typical of an African safari.



Big game - buffalo, leopard, lion, elephant – in its natural environment: man's perpetual struggle with nature, a battle often with no winner. These 22 episodes unite the passion for hunting and nature with the joy of discovering remote populations and their culture as the ancient challenge recounted in the hunts offers another perspective on a country and its people.



### the leopard's challenge

Hunting in West Tanzania requires travelling kilometres by jeep through impassable bush and in difficult conditions, it means hunting almost exclusively by following tracks, continuously searching for the animal, never able to stop and wait. It also offers the chance of coming across a superb 12 year old leopard, of studying its movements for days.



### the cape buffalo

In one of the wildest and most impervious areas of Western Tanzania, we have been following a herd of buffalo for days. Tracking requires true dedication and makes for one of the most adrenalin fuelled types of hunt.



### african big bore

"Big Game Hunting Diaries" dedicates an episode from Tanzania to the African calibres and takes a detailed look at the different fire arms used for Big Game Hunting in Africa. Ranging from the traditional Old Style to the modern performance calibres, comparing opinions between lovers of express and bolt action rifles



### roan: a real big trophy

"Big Game Hunting Diaries" chronicles the physical feat of tracking in the impervious territory of western Tanzania in the purest of African hunting traditions, the hours stalking, the incredible resistance of the wounded animal, the tension of the hunter and his fear of losing the trophy which culminates in the final reward of collecting a beautiful trophy.



### a dangerous lake

In the still waters of a pool, illuminated by the few rays of light able to penetrate the lush vegetation, something moves. First the eyebrow arch, then the dark, thick dorsal skin appear above the surface. It is a herd of hippos. Their raucous, guttural grunts suddenly breaks through the silence. ## Motorcycle



### Altometheus / 2 x 30` or a 1 x 60`

John Renwick, over sixty years old, long time sidecar constructor and racer is an expert tuner of the vintage Vincent engines and he uses a 950s engine with high tech additions to build his aerodynamic sidecar which he intends to take personally to over 280 km/hr on the Bonneville flats in the USA in 2008, competing with younger riders with more modern engines. He is helped by famous and less famous friends: John Surtees among the old hands, photographer and collector Giovanni Cabassi among the sponsors.

John Renwick and Giovanni Cabassi have come together to prove that the Vincent engine, combined with the perfect side car, can break the land speed record

The world land speed record project is the culmination of years of preparation.



### Bonneville Speed Way 2008 / 2 x 30`

Surrounded by an incredible lunar landscape, the expanse of perfectly flat, compacted salt that gives the Capital of Utah its name has been the site, since the 1920's, of the most daring land-speed records. Conditions of climate and geography found nowhere else in the world have made it the ideal setting for memorable feats. Land Speed Records runs open to a wide variety of vehicles, the so-called Speed Weeks, attract speed fanatics from all over the United States

and, by now, from the rest of the world as well. During the week of September 2nd to the 7th, Bonneville fills up with biking enthusiasts, and the party begins, along with the racing, the competition and the attempts to push beyond the rules of speed, wind and space. We take a look at the history, technology and rational madness of riders and mechanics who work for years, in the hope of braking an absolute record for pure speed.



### Mad "Motor Art Design" / 75 x 3`

The 75 most important bikes from the end of the Second World War onwards, in terms of innovation, looks, prestige and rarity, all displayed at the MAD 2007 show, which was held in the intriguing setting of Milan's Ice Palace.

This series is made up of 75 portrays each three minutes, of names like: the Gilera Saturno "Piuma" of Italy, the English Triumph-T 150 Trident and the Britten-CR&S V 1000 from New Zealand. An off-camera voice provides details on each bike, describing its origins, development and technical features, along with anecdotes of interest, the history of its production, any competitive triumphs, rally entries and the make as a whole, plus the competitive bikes of its period.



### 50th Paton Anniversary / 2 x 30`

The 50th anniversary of Paton will be celebrated on the Chimay track in Belgium. For the first time ever, the glorious manufacturer of racing bikes will exhibit all the models it produced in the 60's, 70's, 80's, 90's and the years after 2000. The event provides a unique occasion to admire the many motorcycles that have entered the history of the sport, thrilling the countless enthusiasts who followed the exploits of the Milan manufacturer in 50 years of top-level racing.

But the event is more than just a static exhibition. A number of different models will be taken out on the track and ridden by the racers who once competed on Patons: Roberto Gallina and Vittorio Scatola, Fred Stevens and Paolo Tessari, Armando Toracca and Eric Saul.



## FILMER FORCE TRIP / 10 x 30`



- MASTERS OF DIRT GRAZ (Austria) = second meeting with M.O.D.. The race's form is similar of the first episode made in Wien, but locations and riders are different. We described all the event together with a rider, showing impressions, emotions and backstage of an FMX event.



- FREESTYLE.CH (Switzerland) = it's the biggest happening of Free-Action Sports in Europe! 4 different disciplines crash into each other: FMX, Snowboard, Freeski and Skateboard. Location and Lifestyle really cool and fantastic. The footage done is also so nice (we also used dolly).



- USA TRIP (California) = it's a summary of our California Trip made with Italian riders of DaBoot (Italian fmx crew). We travelled around California and Nevada for 3 weeks, driving a big RV (motorhome), searching good locations (fmx park and spot) to ride FMX and Freeride. It's an unique experience made through the headquarters of this sport! The episode is full of action, lifestyle and big emotions. We also filmed different USA riders, and used helmet-cam a lot.....



- MAT REBEAUD (X-fighters + Switzerland) = special episode dedicated to the Big FMX Champion MAT REBEAUD. Mat is considered one of the 5 best riders of the world. 2008 was a big year for him: he won RedBull X-Fighters Series and took a Second Place at X-Games. We went to his place in Payerne, filmed him during training and a lot of his lifestyle.

- MOTOR SHOW BOLOGNA (Italy) = 4 days at Bologna MotorShow 2008.



- MASTERS OF DIRT Wien (Austria) = M.O.D. is one of the craziest FMX event. There are the best FMX riders and the best BMX and Dirt Jumping riders.



- M.C. Pecquencourt (France) = in the lost North of France, close to Belgium, there is the "Salon de la Moto di Pecquencourt". It's a so original and unique event. There are many shows inside 3 days' exhibition: stunt riders with fast street bikes (also Pfeiffer, the world champion is there); there are extreme shows with Sidecar and Scooters; thousands of real bikers coming from all over Europe transforming the little village in a surreal dimension.



- ITALIAN FMX VIDEOSESSION (Italy) = we made a Special Video Session with 15 FMX riders from all Europe, inside the Alvaro Dal Farra's fmx park in Belluno (Alvaro is the best Italian FMX rider). All the riders were there for our filming session. We made a grand style footage, we also used helmet-cam.



- ERZBERG RODEO (Austria) = Special Episode!!!! Erzberg is an extreme enduro race. FMX is only a show inside the event. Erzberg represents the challenge between man and the mountain. It's an open race from Sunday's riders to pros can start. It's really a Special Event, really cool! The Location is amazing, it's an iron mine (still in function).

- THE INVITATIONALS ( Norway – Ailo Gaup / Belluno – Alvaro) = episode dedicated to Invitationals. They are contests organized by famous riders that invite other riders to come and give big emotions to the public. We first went to Oslo, Norway to film Ailo Gaup's Invitational, and next to Belluno, to film Alvaro's Invitational made for his birthday.

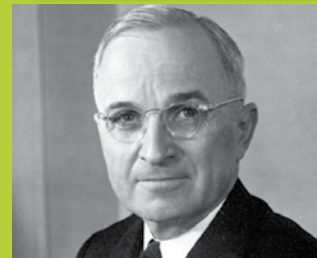
### 20th Century Presidents

#### MRE Tug-of-Wars

Once a year, local and national attention focuses on the Annapolis Harbor — or, as we like to call it, the Gulf of Eastport — for a competition unlike any in the world: the Slaughter Across the Water. It is the longest tug of war over a body of water in the world.
